Automated Tithing

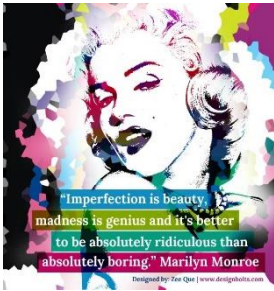
If you would like to enroll in automatic online giving through your bank, follow these easy steps:
