If you would like to enroll in automatic online giving through your bank follow these easy steps:


1. Go to your online bank account.

## Food Pantry Ministry

### Needs

Our Food Pantry is in need of donations, food or monetary. The most commonly requested item is "meat", which we are usually low on. Donations of "canned meat" (tuna, pork, chicken, beef, etc.) are needed. Canned fruit is a needed staple also. There are some clients that have no access to a kitchen so even items that don't need to be cooked are needed. We have a designated Sunday, the Second Sunday of the month that is our "Food Pantry Donation Sunday" but donations can be dropped off any time. Sunday, July 12<sup>th</sup> is our next designated donation day.

New Light MCC's Food Pantry was started several years ago in response to an on going need of church members and individuals in the community for food. The Pantry is supported by the Church and its members. Supplies for the Pantry are donated from congregants and also bought from the Maryland Food Bank. The Pantry is open every other Saturday from 9 am until 10 am. People that use the Pantry come to the church during that time to pick up food. To use the Pantry an individual must fill out an application at the church or be referred from the Department of Social Services.




## **2016** marks our 20th Anniversary as New Light Metropolitan Community Church.
