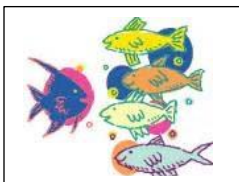

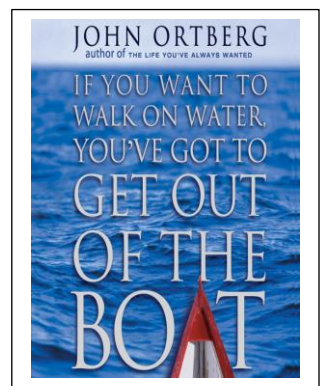

## Holy Week Renewal

In order for us as a community to remember, we have planned dynamic opportunities to experience the journey of Jesus to Jerusalem and the cross. If you want your spiritual journey to come alive, then we hope you will join us for each event.

**Palm Sunday – Sunday, April 9<sup>th</sup>** is the beginning of Holy Week. Come celebrate Jesus' entrance into the city of Jerusalem

**Maundy or Holy Thursday – Thursday, April 13<sup>th</sup>** This service is designed for remembering the Lord's Supper and the commandment that we love one another. We will begin at 6:30pm with a simple meal followed by the sharing of communion.

**Good Friday, - April 14<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm** Reflect on Christ's journey to the cross.

## **The Five Practices of New Light MCC**



**Authentic Worship:** is about people leaving feeling as though they have experienced God. We are called to worship with excellence. John 4:23 tells us "... the true worshipers will worship God in spirit and truth, for they are the kind of worshipers God seeks." We seek to accomplish authentic worship through creative worship planning team, worship leaders, our greeter, our prayer ministry, our a/v sound ministry as well as through our excellent music.

**Purposeful Faith Development:** is about specific practices you involve yourself in so that you can become an authentic disciple. Matthew 6:5 tells us "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled." We seek to accomplish this through Wednesday Night Bible Study, our small group program, our workshops and retreats and through growing our children and youth up in faith through Sunday School and special programs.

**Innovative Hospitality:** is about making a commitment to invite, welcome, include, and support people. Innovative Hospitality reminds us as Jesus states in Matthew 20:28 "he came not to be served but to serve." We seek to accomplish this through our Sunday and Special Events Hospitality team, our congregational care program, our intercessory prayer team and our connection teams.

**Life Changing Service:** is about reaching out. We are challenged as Christians to reach out to others and work for justice as Jesus did. For those of us who are followers of Christ, it is not an option to love, to teach, to heal and to associate with the outcast, & the marginalized. We seek to accomplish this through our outreach projects in the community, our projects to draw people to our community of faith, Pride events, and our social justice activities.

**Abundant Generosity:** is about the giving of our dollars to support the work of New Light MCC. 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 8: 11b-12 says "Give in proportion to what you have. Whatever you give is acceptable if you give it eagerly. We are called to practice generosity.
